**NOTICES OF MOTION**

**1. NOTICE OF MOTION: ENGAGEMENT OF CASUAL WORKERS  
(HON. NEWTON KIFUSO, MCA, WUMINGU/KISHUSHE WARD,  
MINORITY LEADER)**

**AWARE THAT**, maintenance of County roads and markets is a function of the County Government, pursuant to Schedule 4 Part 2 (5) (a) and (7) (a) of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010.

**NOTING THAT**, some of the County roads are in a dilapidated state hampering the movement of goods and services. This is greatly experienced during heavy rainfall and contributed by environmental degradation caused by the effects of erosion in the arid and semi-arid areas in the County.

**FURTHER NOTING THAT**, roads open up remote areas for the benefit of businesses, improved communication and road network that enable farmers produce to reach the markets at less costs. These roads have a significant potential for accessibility of local resources, supporting and strengthening of local economic development.

**COGNIZANT THAT**, markets in the County require regular cleaning to ensure trading activities are conducted in a clean and conducive environment. However, due to shortage of cleaners, most markets are not cleaned up causing traders to conduct business in an unfriendly environment.

**FURTHER COGNIZANT THAT**, maintenance and rehabilitation of roads and cleaning of markets will create employment opportunities for the youth which will go a long way in cushioning them during hard times as they will be able to cater for their basic needs and those of their immediate families.

**NOW THEREFORE**, this County Assembly **RESOLVES** that the County Government employs 10 casual workers from each Ward comprising of youth, women and PWD's; 4 to maintain and rehabilitate County roads and 6 to clean markets and shopping centres on a contract basis of three months.

**STATEMENTS**

**1. STATEMENT: IMPLEMENTATION STATUS OF COUNTY ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION (HON. STEPHEN NZAI, MCA MARUNGU WARD, CHAIRPERSON, AGRICULTURE, LIVESTOCK AND FISHERIES COMMITTEE)**

**Mr. Speaker, Sir**, in line with the provisions of the Taita Taveta County Assembly Standing Order No. 42 (2) (c), a Member of the House can seek a statement requiring availability of information, clarification or appearance on any substantive issue, circumstances, situations and matters appertaining to the attention of County Governments, the National Government, or any Public Entity where such mandates related to the management of service and leadership to the citizens and institutions, as per the Constitution of Kenya, 2010, and our current laws are concerned. In view of the above, I would like to seek a statement on the implementation status of County Assembly resolution.

**Mr. Speaker, Sir**, on 12<sup>th</sup> October, 2021, the Second County Assembly Committee of the Whole House held a deliberative session and RESOLVED that the County Chief Officer, Department of Livestock and Fisheries and the County Public Service Board, reinstates six employees who were re-designated as herder to the position of slaughter house supervisors and that their salary arrears be computed and paid. The resolution was officially communicated to the County Secretary/Head of Public Service and the Department for implementation.

**Mr. Speaker, Sir**, the County Secretary, in response vide a letter dated 2<sup>nd</sup> June, 2022, referenced SF/GOV/TT/ADM.12/NR/VOL.3/48, communicated the implementation status of the County Assembly resolution. The resolution was however partly implemented as only three out of the six staff were reinstated effective 28<sup>th</sup> January, 2022.
