**FURTHER NOTING THAT**, roads open up remote areas for the benefit of businesses, improved communication and road network that enable farmers produce to reach the markets at less costs. These roads have a significant potential for accessibility of local resources, supporting and strengthening of local economic development.

**COGNIZANT THAT**, markets in the County require regular cleaning to ensure trading activities are conducted in a clean and conducive environment. However, due to shortage of cleaners, most markets are not cleaned up causing traders to conduct business in an unfriendly environment.

**FURTHER COGNIZANT THAT**, maintenance and rehabilitation of roads and cleaning of markets will create employment opportunities for the youth which will go a long way in cushioning them during hard times as they will be able to cater for their basic needs and those of their immediate families.

**NOW THEREFORE**, this County Assembly **RESOLVES** that the County Government employs 10 casual workers from each Ward comprising of youth, women and PWD's; 4 to maintain and rehabilitate County roads and 6 to clean markets and shopping centres on a contract basis of three months.

NOTICE

LIMITATION OF DEBATE

The House resolved on Tuesday, October 11<sup>th</sup>, 2022 as follows-

Limitation of Debate on Motion

**THAT**, NOTWITHSTANDING the provisions of Standing Order 96(4), this House orders that, for purposes of this THIRD COUNTY ASSEMBLY OF TAITA TAVETA, FIRST SESSION, 2022 each speech in a debate on any **Motion**, including a Special motion be limited as follows:- A maximum of **twenty (20) minutes** for the Mover and **ten (10) minutes** for each other Member speaking, except the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party, who shall be limited to a maximum of **fifteen (15) minutes** each, and that priority in speaking be accorded to the Leader of the Majority Party, the Leader of the Minority Party and the Chairperson of the relevant Departmental Committee, in that Order.
