THE TAITA TAVETA COUNTY FINANCE BILL

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An Act of the County Assembly of Taita Taveta to provide for the various Taxes, fees, and other charges for service rendered by the County Government of Taita Taveta, and for other revenue raising measures, and for matters incidental thereto

ENACTED by the County Assembly of Taita Taveta as follows-;

PRELIMINARY

Short title and commencement.

1.(1) This Act may be cited as the Taita Taveta County Finance Amendment Act, 2013 and shall come into operation on such a date as the County Executive Committee Member in charge of Finance may appoint and

different dates may be appointed for different provisions.

Interpretation 1.(2)

In this Act unless the content otherwise requires;

- (i) Commencement date : The date when the Bill is assented to Act, operational date.
- (ii) Other fees and charges: The revenue raising measures of the county government relating to fees and charges for services are set out in schedule 1
- (iii) **Trade licenses:** The revenue raising measures of the county government relating to trade licenses are set out in **schedule 2.**
- (iv) Maximum threshold weight: The maximum weights of the County government relating to agricultural produce cess are set out in schedule 3
 - (v) Holding ground A place set aside for safe custody of animals
 - (vi) Towns Areas like Voi CBD, Taveta CBD, Mwatate CBD and

Wundanyi CBD

- (vii) Other areas Other places within the county other than the mentioned Towns
- (vii) Zone A Highly economically viable (Voi and Taveta CBD)
- (viii) Zone B Medium economically viable (Mwatate and Wundanyi CBD)

(x) Property tax Taxes charged on rated plots

(xi) Designated parking area Areas set aside for daily parking

(Xii) Enclosed parking Area set aside for parking which has entry and exit

(xiii) Agricultural produce fees Farm produce fees charged on goods moving within and outside the county

(xiv) By-Laws Regulations governing the Finance Bill

(xv) Plot Rent monthly and annual rent charged on plot

(xvi) Fees and Charges Stipulated fees to be charged on all goods/services

Transition of bylaws into Acts of the County Assembly.

- 2. (1) Except where the Constitution and this Act provides to the contrary, all the by-laws enacted by the defunct local authorities within Taita Taveta County existing prior to the first elections on 4th of March, 2013, shall by the operation of this Act, be deemed to be Acts made by the County Assembly of Taita Taveta until such by-laws are specifically repealed or replaced by County legislation.
 - (2) If any national Act mentioned in schedule 3 has not been amended to provide for provision for imposition of fees or charges for services by the County government, then item 7 of the sixth schedule of the constitution applies in relation to that Act.

(1) Upon commencement of this Act-

- (a) the taxes, fees and charges as stipulated in the by-laws referred to under subsection (1) shall, subject to section 3, be payable to the County Government of Taita Taveta until such by-laws are repealed, replaced or amended by subsequent County legislation;
- (b) the administrative directions, resolutions, orders and authorizations on or relating to financial management, including the collection and administration of taxes, fees and charges issued under the by-laws referred to in subsection (1) shall be deemed to have been issued, made or given under the authority of the County Government of Taita Taveta and shall with necessary modifications, apply to the payment and administration of the taxes, fees, charges and other levies under the Act until the expiry, amendment, or repeal of those directions, orders and authorizations on financial management.

Amendment of fees in by-laws

3. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 2-

- (a) the scale of taxes, fees and other charges in respect services rendered by the County Government in respect of the services of the description specified in the first column of the First Schedule shall be as respectively specified in the second & third column of that Schedule as may be the case and the fee, taxes or other charges existing in the by-laws referred to in section 2(1) shall be construed as amended in the manner specified in the First Schedule;
- (b) the scale of taxes, fees and other charges in respect services rendered by the County Government in respect of the services of the description specified in the first column of the Second and Third Schedule shall be as respectively specified in the

applicable column of that respective Schedule as may be the case and the fee, taxes or other charges existing in the by-laws referred to in section 2(1) shall be construed as amended in the manner specified in the respective Second and Third Schedule;

(2). Where the fees, tax or other charge specified in the First, Second or Third Schedule does not exist in an existing by-law referred to in section 2, that fee, tax or other charge shall be deemed to be payable in respect of the subject matter pending the enactment of legislation by the County Assembly to provide for the subject matter.

Penalties on outstanding rates/rent.

4. (1) With effect from 1st December, 2014-

- (a) in the case of a property having total outstanding rates at the turn of the calendar year, the amount of property tax computed shall be calculated at 1% cumulative per month;
- (b) in the case of a property owned by national government the property- tax computed, in this case the contribution in lieu of rates outstanding shall be calculated at 1% for the purpose of such property tax but marginal relief shall be allowed in cases where the amount is cleared by the turn of the year to ensure that annual amount of the property tax payable does not accrue penalties until after 31st of March in each calendar year;
- (c) in the case of a property with a registered title deed total property tax under this section and where such properties having been registered for more than seven years preceding the year of notification, marginal relief;
- (d) In the case of house rent a surcharge shall be levied for rental default at a cumulative rate of 10% per month by 10^{th} of every month.
- (2) With effect from 1st January, 2015 in the event of single business license of a business having total outstanding licenses at the turn of the calendar year the amount of license computed shall be increased by a penalty calculated at 3% cumulative per month but a marginal relief shall be allowed in cases where the amount is cleared by the turn of the year to ensure that annual amount of single business permit payable does not accrue penalties until after 31st of march in each calendar year.

MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

The Bill is prepared pursuant to Article 209 and the Fourth Schedule to the Constitution, section 213 of the Public Finance Management Act (No. 18 of 2012) 132 dealing with revenue raising measures for County Governments and Standing Order and 218 dealing with the form of the County Finance Bill.

This Bill seeks to provide the appropriate legislative framework and power upon which the County Government charges revenue for services. In this regard, the Bill firstly transits all the by-laws that were existing prior to the coming into operation of the county government of Taita Taveta in as far as those by –laws are not in conflict with the constitution and any county legislation that may be made. Secondly, the Bill provides for an amendment to the fees imposed under those bylaws in the manner specified in the Schedule. These proposed rates are premised upon the increased role of the County under its specific mandate as provided for in the Fourth Schedule of the Constitution and the need to improve services and service delivery to the people of Taita Taveta County.

The Bill acknowledges the need for the existence of specific County legislation with respect to the different sectors within the competence of and jurisdiction of the County Assembly in accordance to the Fourth Schedule of the Constitution. It is assumed that the County Assembly will gradually make comprehensive legislation in respect of each particular subject matter which action will pave way for their consideration and improvement including setting out measures to improve accountability among public and state officers managing revenue at the County Government.

The Executive Committee Member responsible for Finance is empowered to bring into operation the various provisions of the Act or certain sections of the schedule. This is to enable the putting into place of necessary infrastructural machinery, both personnel and physical infrastructure that will ensure the ultimate implementation of the collection of the proposed taxes, fees and charges.

The Bill, 2014 relating to taxes seeks to repeal and re-enact the gazetted fees and charges and single business schedules, *inter alia*, in order to provide for the tax rates, fees and charges, widening of tax base and measures to prevent non remittance of collected revenue, tax incentives and reliefs, rationalization of intercounty taxation provisions and general anti-evasion rule. The Bill seeks to prescribe the rates of taxes and charges for the assessment year 2014-15 in respect of properties (including land and buildings), businesses, markets, agricultural produce, outdoor advertisement, health services, vehicle parking, heritage sites, County parks, and entertainment and extraction activities.

The Bill also seeks to amend the following laws-

The Single Business permits Legislation

The Bill seeks to propose subsidiary legislation as contemplated by section 23 of the County public finance management transition Act 2013 to prescribe the amount relating to different categories of businesses and harmonize the business licenses into a single regime.

Outdoor Advertisement Legislation

The Bill seeks to propose subsidiary legislation as contemplated by section 23 of the County public finance management transition Act 2013 to prescribe the objects of advertisements and rates applicable on an annual basis.

Property Tax Legislation

The Bill seeks to propose subsidiary legislation as contemplated by section 23 of the County public finance management transition Act 2013 to prescribe the struck rate for property tax and its general administration

Market legislation

The Bill seeks to propose subsidiary legislation as contemplated by section 23 of the County public finance management transition Act 2013 to prescribe the management of designated market, packaging of produce destined for the county markets and the levying of fees and charges within the county.

Control of Traffic and Parking

The Bill seeks to propose subsidiary legislation as contemplated by section 23 of the County Public Finance Management transition Act 2013 to prescribe designated parking areas and the fees applicable on a daily, monthly, quarterly and annual basis in addition operation areas for various categories vehicles and two wheeled motoring vehicles

Mining legislation

The Bill seeks to propose subsidiary legislation as contemplated by section 23 of the County public finance management transition Act 2013 to prescribe minerals for collection of royalties, the rate applicable and the general administration

Building Legislation

The Bill seeks to propose subsidiary legislation as contemplated by section 23 of the County public finance management transition Act 2013 to prescribe control of development, rates for building plan approval and inspection including greenhouses as enacted in the physical planning act.

Agricultural Produce cess Legislation

The Bill seeks to propose subsidiary legislation

Taxi cab

The Bill seeks to propose subsidiary legislation as contemplated by section 23 of the County public finance management transition Act 2013 to prescribe designated parking areas and the fees applicable on a daily, monthly, quarterly and annual basis in addition operation areas taxi cabs

Polythene

The Bill seeks to propose subsidiary legislation as contemplated by section 23 of the County public finance management transition Act 2013 to prescribe the control and disposal of polythene bags

Hawkers

The Bill seeks to propose subsidiary legislation as contemplated by section 23 of the County public finance management transition Act 2013 to prescribe time and designated area of operation of hawking business

General Nuisance

The Bill seeks to propose subsidiary legislation as contemplated by section 23 of the County public finance management transition Act 2013 to prescribe occurrence of public nuisance and measure to controlling and managing nuisance

Control of Dogs

The Bill seeks to propose subsidiary legislation as contemplated by section 23 of the County public finance management transition Act 2013 to prescribe the control and licensing of dogs

Slaughter house

The Bill seeks to propose subsidiary legislation as contemplated by section 23 of the County public finance management transition Act 2013 to prescribe the licensing, control and management of slaughter houses and abattoirs.

Pound by laws

Batter market by laws

Control of Motor bike and bodaboda

Public lavatories

The Bill seeks to propose subsidiary legislation as contemplated by section 23 of the County public finance management transition Act 2013 to prescribe licensing and management of lavatories.

Solid waste management

The Bill seeks to propose subsidiary legislation as contemplated by section 23 of the County public finance management transition Act 2013 to prescribe control and management of solid waste

Rental House

The Bill seeks to propose subsidiary legislation as contemplated by section 23 of the County public finance management transition Act 2013 to prescribe the charges and management of lavatories.

Liquor licensing

The Bill seeks to propose subsidiary legislation as contemplated by section 23 of the County public finance management transition Act 2013 to prescribe licensing procedure, general administration and control of liquor processing and sale.

Betting and Casino control
