**10. *PROCEDURAL MOTION - LIMITATION OF DEBATE ON REPORT
OF A COMMITTEE (HON. JASON TUJA, MCA WERUGHA WARD, THE
LEADER OF THE MAJORITY PARTY)**

THAT, notwithstanding the provisions of Standing Order 96(4), this House orders that, for purposes of this TAITA TAVETA COUNTY ASSEMBLY FOURTH SESSION, 2020 each speech in a debate on a **Report of a Committee** or any other Report submitted to the House, be limited as follows: - A maximum of thirty (30) minutes for the Mover in moving and fifteen (15) minutes in replying, and a maximum of ten (10) minutes for any other Member speaking, except the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party, who shall be limited to a maximum of fifteen (15) minutes each; and that priority be accorded to the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party, in that Order.

STATEMENT

STATEMENT: LIST OF ALL TAITA TAVETA COUNTY COUNCILLORS
SINCE 1963. (HON.CHRISTOPHER MWAMBINGU, MCA,
CHAIRPERSON PUBLIC ACCOUNTS COMMITTEE)

Mr. Speaker, Sir, in line with the provisions of the Taita Taveta County Assembly Standing Order No. 42 (2) (c), a Member of the House can seek a statement requiring availability of information, clarification or appearance on any substantive issue, circumstances, situations and matters appertaining to the attention of County Governments, the National Government, or any Public Entity where such mandates related to the management of service and leadership to the citizens and institutions, as per the Constitution of Kenya, 2010, and our current laws are concerned.

Mr. Speaker, Sir, in reference to the National Treasurer and Planning letter to the County Assemblies Forum dated 18th November, 2019 **Ref EPN 172/01 VOL 'A' (62)**, on *Former Councillors Details*, I stand to seek a statement from the County Assembly Service Board on the list of all Taita Taveta County former councillors since 1963.

Mr. Speaker, Sir, the PS. Treasury on 23rd April, 2019 constituted a Multi-Agency Taskforce with a mandate to study, deliberate and make recommendations on the issue of possible payment of pension benefits for former councillors.

Mr. Speaker, Sir, in order to facilitate the taskforce in carrying out its mandate, the National Treasury through the Taskforce Secretary required the 47 County Assemblies to furnish the following information preferably by 1st December 2019;

1. List of all councillors who served in the period between 1963 and 4th March 2013

2. Names of all councillors paid pension benefits by the respective councils in accordance with the regulations/circulars in place during that period
3. Any additional information that may assist the taskforce to realize their objective

Mr. Speaker, Sir, I hereby require the County Assembly Service Board to inform this House of the following;

1. Has the list of all former Taita Taveta County councillors been compiled and submitted? If not,
2. The County Assembly Service Board is urged to fast-track the compilation of the list for onward submission.

Mr. Speaker, Sir, I also request that the County Secretary furnishes this House with the progress report of payment of gratuity for the former councillors by the Intergovernmental Relations Forum.
