UPDATE ON THE COVID 19 SITUATION

A week ago, one of our staff members tested positive for Covid-19, prompting the suspension of all County Assembly activities and subsequent closure of the Assembly for 14 days. All primary contacts of the infected were put on mandatory self-quarantine. This was done to protect the Members of County Assembly (MCAs) and staff, their families and the general public.

The County Assembly undertook mandatory testing for all Members of the County Assembly and staff. Unfortunately, two more members of staff were found to be positive, bringing the total to 3, all asymptomatic. The three are under home-based care and isolation.

All the MCAs were, however, confirmed to be negative.

The County Assembly has put in place mitigative measures to stop further spreading of the virus, including fumigation of the Assembly offices. Members of the public will be kept updated on the re-opening of the County Assembly.

At the same time, we continue urging all members of the public to strictly adhere to the MOH guidelines on Covid-19 prevention, in light of the recent spike in infections of Covid-19 in the County.
