REPORT ON THE ANALYSIS AND REVIEW OF THE TAITA TAVETA COUNTY FINANCE BILL, 2020

OCTOBER, 2020

# INTRODUCTION

Pursuant to the provisions of the Public Finance Management Act, 2012, section 132(2), the County Executive Committee Member for Finance, is required to submit to the County Assembly the County Finance Bill which sets out the revenue raising measures for the County Government together with a policy statement expounding on those measures. The section 133 0f the PFM Act 2012, states that not later than ninety days after passing the Appropriation Bill, the County Assembly shall consider and approve the Finance Bill with or without any amendments. In line with the provisions of the PFM Act 2012 Section 132 (3), any recommendations made by the relevant committee or adopted by the County Assembly on revenue matters shall:

- 1. Ensure that the total amount of revenue raised is consistent with the approved fiscal framework and the County Allocation of Revenue Act.
- 2. Take into account the principles of equity, certainty and ease of collection.
- 3. Consider the impact of the proposed changes on the composition of tax revenue with reference to direct and indirect taxes.
- 4. Consider domestic regional and international tax trends.
- 5. Consider the impact on development, investment, employment and economic growth.
- 6. Take into account, the taxation and other tariff agreements and obligations that Kenya has ratified including taxation and tariff agreement under the East African Community treaty.

The committee met at Mombasa beach from 1<sup>st</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> October, 2020 and scrutinized the finance bill, 2020 with a view of understanding the contents of the bill and whether the bill had broadened the county's' tax bracket by introducing new taxes. This was then followed by public participation where the committee was out to seek the views of the DATUZENS from 30<sup>th</sup> September to 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2020 in all the 20

wards pursuant to the provisions of Article 196(1b), which states that a County Assembly shall, facilitate Public Participation and involvement in the legislative and other businesses of the Assembly and its Committees.

The review of the Finance Bill, 2020 is therefore guided by the above outlined legal requirements which will form the basis of putting forward any relevant recommendations.

market fees which have been reduced by half to help revive markets within the county as they have been grossly affected by the COVID 19 pandemic. However, some of the proposed rates are too high for the business outlined in the respective tax brackets.

Certainty – Relying on the performance of last year's finance bill, it can easily be deduced that the county is certain that it will meet its collections targets by using this year's finance bill. Besides, the county has increased the number of revenue clerks/enforcement officers – in the past one year, the department of finance and economic planning has employed more revenue clerks and enforcement officers. This has in turn ensured

## OTHER GENERAL FINDINGS/OBSERVATIONS

The committee, during its scrutiny and the various public participation forums made the following observations on the 2020/2021 budget estimates which approved own source revenue as Kshs. 363 million. It's worth noting that this can only be achieved by an approval of a good Finance Act with realistic fees, charges and taxes. Below are other general observations:

- 1. The bill was brought to the assembly in the right time in accordance with PFM Act of 2012 Section 133.
- 2. Arrangement of clauses and schedules in the bill were not clearly spelt out i.e. the bill highlights the first, fifth and sixth schedules but it does not clearly show second, third and fourth schedules.
- 3. Interpretations of terms used in the bill i.e. Bond and bail etc. were not found in the interpretation clause.
- 4. The 2020/2021 budget estimates approved own source revenue as Kshs. 363 million. The County Treasury managed to collect 300 million in the financial year 2019/2020 despite of the fact that the Covid 19 pandemic was biting hard on the economy. It's therefore possible for the County to collect the projected 363 million in the 2020/2021 budget.
- 5. The committee noted several newly introduced levies in the bill across the departments.
- 6. The committee revealed increased/decreased active (already in force) levies in the bill during the scrutiny.
- 7. The committee noted that governor's executive orders, which were made in the last financial year's finance bill 2019, were still in effect.

## These were the general concerns and proposals from the public:

- More enforcement officers should be deployed to areas like Chala to ensure they get the traders who are trading without licenses in remote areas.
- AI services have not been available to citizens in Chala area due to faulty storage facilities for almost a year, hence it is difficult for those need the services and who are willing to pay to get the services.
- Public participation documents should be made available to the public a week before the scheduled date of public participation to enable ample time for perusal and understanding of the document.
- Governor's executive order should be done after consultation with the concerned stakeholders

- Sensitization of public on the revenues paid and the mode in which they should pay should be done so as to curb loss of revenue through corruption for instance, in public toilets, the public should be sensitized to understand that they should request for a receipt as proof of payment to use those facilities.
- Revenue officers should be paid well in order to motivate them to work and reduce corruption.
- All local administrators should be notified in order for public participation information to reach a greater audience for instance in Chala ward, the chief, sub-chief and village elders were not aware of the schedule public participation.
- Communication of the public participation should be done early enough. Some of the attendees complained that they had been called to attended barely half an hour before the scheduled time for the public participation. Others complained that they hadn't been communicated to at all, they got the information from those who were already in attendance as the public participation was on going.

- Define what entails nonpayment. In some cases, revenue officers are absent from cess stations making residents not to pay. They are later accused of nonpayment and charged with fines.
- Licenses for Small Business permits should consolidate all the other charges included and indicated on the Finance bill. Residents are tired of the additional charges at the revenue office that are not indicated on the finance bill.
- Market people are being over taxed. They pay cess for their produce, market fees and licenses for stalls. They request to be taxed less.
- All taxes to be reduced for this financial year to allow residents to recover from the Corona Pandemic.

- > There is a no tax administration law in the County to cover any loopholes for embezzlement of revenue collected by revenue clerks. Residents want this tax administration law in the county.
- > Tax should be increased where services are being offered.
- > Tax officers and revenue clerks should not be employed on contract of causal basis so as to curb the menace of revenue embezzlement.
- Public opinions during public participation should be captured and not to be ignored. Rates being suggested by the public should be considered. The finance act should have the proposed changes to avoid court battles as witnessed last time.
- > Distribution of documents and mobilization should always be done early i.e. 7 days prior to the public participation day to enable the people thoroughly go through the document and point out the areas of concern.
- Anything being introduced as new should be well elaborated to clearly show what it exactly is being changed to avoid confrontations with traders.
- > Bus parking fees should be charged daily and not monthly.
- > Tax operators should be given options when paying for their parking fees. Those capable of paying the 6,000 per year should do so and those not capable should be allowed to pay daily rates.
- > Under Library charges, residents raised concerns on the need to have mobile libraries so that children in remote areas to also benefit.
- Library charges should be per week or monthly. Daily fees would be expensive and not all will be able to afford.
- ➤ Libraries should introduce membership cards. This will enable students to lend books at a lower/cheaper rates.
- > Traders who deal with hides and skins are being double charged cess fees both at the slaughter house and at the markets.
- > Local businessmen are being overcharged for landing and stock auction fees.
- All market fees as reduced by the Governors executive order be retained even after expiry of the order. Fees should not be hiked or changed.
- New highway market (10' by 10') charges should be well elaborated, if the fee is not payable to the County Government then it should not be in the finance bill.
