1. STATEMENT: STATUS OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE ECDE SCHEME OF SERVICE RESOLUTION IN TAITA TAVETA COUNTY (HON. DONALD FUNDI, MCA, MAHOO WARD, MEMBER OF THE COUNTY ASSEMBLY POWERS AND PRIVILEGE COMMITTEE)

Mr. Speaker, Sir, in line with the provisions of the Taita Taveta County Assembly Standing Order No. 41, a Member of the House can seek a statement requiring availability of information, clarification or appearance on any substantive issue, circumstances, situations and matters appertaining to the attention of County Governments, the National Government, or any Public Entity where such mandates related to the management of service and leadership to the citizens and institutions, as per the Constitution of Kenya, 2010, and our current laws are concerned;

Mr. Speaker, Sir, a letter dated 5th January, 2022 referenced COG/6/39VOL 13(94) addressed to the County Executive Committee Members of Finance, Education and County Secretaries for the 47 County Governments addressing a Resolution on the Early Childhood Development and Education sector stating that the Council of Governors has approved the ECDE Teachers Scheme of service.

Mr. Speaker, Sir, the scheme of service, 383, states that serving preparatory assistants will be absorbed on Permanent and Pensionable terms of service. This will also allow them enjoy a new and improved monthly package, as well as provide the teachers with the opportunity for career progression.

Mr. Speaker sir, the new scheme of service will attract qualified personnel and will lead to improved performance and service delivery across the Counties.
