MOTION: DEVELOPMENT OF TAITA TAVETA COUNTY SPATIAL PLAN (HON. BRAYSON MWAMBI, MCA, SAGALLA WARD, CHAIRPERSON, WATER AND IRRIGATION SERVICES COMMITTEE)

NOTING THAT, Section 8 of Part 2 of the Fourth Schedule of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010, provides that the functions and powers of the County include County Planning and Development;

AWARE THAT, Section 107 of the County Governments Act, 2012 states that to guide, harmonize and facilitate development within each County there shall be a County Spatial Plan among other plans;

FURTHER AWARE THAT, Section 110 (3) of the County Governments Act, 2012 stipulates that each County Spatial Plan shall be developed by the County Executive Committee and approved by the respective County Assemblies in accordance with procedures approved by the respective County Assembly;

COGNIZANT THAT, the second County Assembly approved the Taita Taveta County Spatial Planning Act, 2022 with the objectives of providing for a legal framework for preparation and implementation of County Spatial Plans and related development plans so as to;

- a. coordinate spatial planning and development;
- b. promote organized planning and development of physical infrastructure;
- c. enhance regulation of physical development and land use;
- d. promote effective and transparent physical planning process;
- e. promote sustainable social economic development.

NOW THEREFORE, I urge that this Third County Assembly **RESOLVES** that the County Executive Committee fast tracks the implementation of the Taita Taveta County Spatial Planning Act, 2022 and subsequently develops the Taita Taveta County Spatial Plan for approval by the County Assembly.

NOTICES OF MOTION

1. NOTICE OF MOTION: TAITA TAVETA COUNTY GOVERNMENT TO EMPLOY ECDE TEACHERS ON PERMANENT AND PENSIONABLE TERMS: (HON. LAWRENCE MZUGHA, MCA MBOLOLO WARD AND DEPUTY MAJORITY LEADER)

AWARE THAT education is a fundamental right to all children in Kenya.

FURTHER AWARE THAT, effective early child education is a requirement in basic education.

NOTING THAT, motivation of teachers increases their zeal to perform. Incentives such as good scheme of service needs be put in place.

FURTHER NOTING THAT, employing ECDE teachers on permanent and pensionable terms of service assures the teachers of job security.

COGNIZANT THAT, most ECDE teachers are employed on three years contract term.

CONCERNED THAT, terminating teachers service midstream jeopardize a child's academic performance, brought about by familiarization of the new teacher.

FURTHER CONCERNED THAT, ECDE teachers need assurance of job security by the employer for maximum service delivery.

NOW THEREFORE, the County Assembly of Taita Taveta urges the County Government of Taita Taveta through the department of education and libraries to:

- i) Make sure that all ECDE teachers are hired on permanent and pensionable terms
- ii) All ECDE teachers whose contracts have expired are absorbed back on permanent and pensionable terms.
- iii) ECDE teachers who were laid off previously due to expiry of their contracts are given first priority when hiring to fill the void in pupil teacher ratio.
- iv) That all ECDE centers are properly staffed to meet the recommended pupil teacher ratio.
