8. **MOTION: TAITA TAVETA COUNTY GOVERNMENT TO EMPLOY ECDE TEACHERS ON PERMANENT AND PENSIONABLE TERMS: (HON. LAWRENCE MZUGHA, MCA MBOLOLO WARD AND DEPUTY MAJORITY LEADER)**

AWARE THAT education is a fundamental right to all children in Kenya.

FURTHER AWARE THAT, effective early child education is a requirement in basic education.

NOTING THAT, motivation of teachers increases their zeal to perform. Incentives such as good scheme of service needs be put in place.

FURTHER NOTING THAT, employing ECDE teachers on permanent and pensionable terms of service assures the teachers of job security.

COGNIZANT THAT, most ECDE teachers are employed on three years contract term.

CONCERNED THAT, terminating teachers service midstream jeopardize a child's academic performance, brought about by familiarization of the new teacher.

FURTHER CONCERNED THAT, ECDE teachers need assurance of job security by the employer for maximum service delivery.

NOW THEREFORE, the County Assembly of Taita Taveta urges the County Government of Taita Taveta through the department of education and libraries to:

- i) Make sure that all ECDE teachers are hired on permanent and pensionable terms
- ii) All ECDE teachers whose contracts have expired are absorbed back on permanent and pensionable terms.
- iii) ECDE teachers who were laid off previously due to expiry of their contracts are given first priority when hiring to fill the void in pupil teacher ratio.
- iv) That all ECDE centers are properly staffed to meet the recommended pupil teacher ratio.

1. STATEMENT: BACKGROUND INFORMATION ON THE INVESTORS INTRODUCED TO THE COUNTY ASSEMBLY BY THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE ON 5TH DECEMBER 2022 (HON. DORCAS MLUGHU, MCA RONG'E WARD, MINORITY CHIEF WHIP)

MR. SPEAKER SIR, in line with the parliamentary best practices, precedents and conventions, and pursuant to the provisions of the Third Taita Taveta County Assembly Standing Order No. 42(2) (c) relating to the Sitting's ORDER NO. 7 (STATEMENTS), I rise to seek a Statement from the Committee Trade, ICT, Industry and Cooperative Development concerning the background information on the investors introduced to the County Assembly by the County Executive.

MR SPEAKER SIR, on the 5th of December 2022 this honorable house was introduced to a consortium of consultants including Taivo Holdings Ltd, Abbi Organic Agriculture and ZPEC whereby each presented themselves individually as limited liability companies while none of the consulting companies made known their physical addresses or registration status

MR. SPEAKER, SIR, the statement by the Committee on Trade, ICT and Cooperative Developments should give the following information to this House within the next 7 days;

1. Copies of registration certificates for each of the companies.
2. List of directors of each of the companies.
3. Most recent returns filed with the registrar of companies.
4. Most recent audited financial statements of each of the companies.
5. Evidence of successfully completed projects/initiative within the republic of Kenya.
6. Information on the asset base of each of the companies
