NOTICE OF MOTION

1. NOTICE OF MOTION: SETTLEMENT OF PARANGA SUB LOCATION RESIDENTS (Hon. Newton Kifuso, MCA, Wumingu Kishushe Ward, Minority Party Leader)

AWARE THAT, the residents of Paranga sub location in Wumingu Kishushe Ward have been squatters since independence because their ancestral land was once allocated to Kidai Sisal Estate.

FURTHER AWARE THAT, the owners and /or successors of that enterprise are still holding onto the title deed and the land to the detriment of our people.

NOTING THAT, the allocated land is in two parcels each measuring approximately 5000 acres, for LR No.4718 Kedai and LR No.5951 Paranga.

DEEPLY CONCERNED THAT, in the event the title deed holders decide to re-develop the property, will result to displacement and suffering of thousands of people, since they have nowhere else to go.

APPRECIATING THAT, Article 40 of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010, states that the state is not allowed to deprive any person land or of any interest in land unless that deprivation is for a public purpose or for public interest.

NOW THEREFORE, the County Assembly of Taita Taveta RESOLVES that the County Government of Taita Taveta engages the National Government through Settlement Trust Fund within the provisions of the Lands Act, No. 6 of 2012 to acquire the 10,000 acres of land and settle the landless residents of Paranga through the Settlement Trust Fund.

- iii. List of contractors and suppliers paid in the financial year 2022-2023?
- iv. How much did the County accumulate as pending bills in the financial year 2022-2023?
- v. How much was paid as pending bills in the financial year 2022-2023?
