**3. STATEMENT: STATUS OF PREPAREDNESS IN MITIGATING THE IMPACT OF EL NINO RAINS IN THE COUNTY (HON. AMOS MAKALO, MCA KASIGAU WARD, DEPUTY MINORITY LEADER)**

**MR. SPEAKER, SIR,** in line with the parliamentary best practices, precedents and conventions, and pursuant to the provisions of the Taita Taveta County Assembly Standing Order No. 42(2) (c) relating to the Sitting's ORDER NO. 7 (STATEMENTS), a Member of the House can seek a statement requiring availability of information, clarification or appearance on any substantive issue, circumstances, situations and matters appertaining to the attention of County Governments, the National Government, or any Public Entity where such mandates related to the management of service and leadership to the citizens and institutions, as per the Constitution of Kenya, 2010, and our current laws are concerned;

In view of the foregoing, I rise to seek a statement regarding the status of preparedness in the mitigation of the impact of El Nino rains in the County.

**MR. SPEAKER, SIR,** the fourteen functions outlined in the FOURTH SCHEDULE of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010, are stipulations amongst which functions 24 and 14 in PARTS ONE and TWO are disaster management.

**MR. SPEAKER, SIR,** I would like the Chairperson of Committee on Administration, Security, Devolution, Public Participation, Community Services & Drugs Control to furnish this House with the following information within 7 days;

1. What plans has the department put in place to ensure that there is quick response in case of any negative or positive impact of the anticipated El Nino rains such as flash floods which may cause displacement of people especially those living the low lands, destruction of property and any short/long term interventions such provision of agricultural seeds, manure and fertilizer so as to boost food production amongst others?
2. Does the department have a disaster management response team? If yes, why has the team not been active in assisting Datuzens who have been affected by natural disasters?
3. Aware that there is an existing Emergency Fund established under the Taita Taveta County Emergency Fund Act, 2020. What is the status of the Fund? How much money was allocated to the fund in this 2023/2024 budget to ensure that Datuzens affected by natural disasters receive assistance?
