THAT, this Third County Assembly adopts and approves the report of the Select Committee on Water And Irrigation on the site visits to major water sources in the County laid on the Table of this House on Tuesday 23rd July, 2024, Morning Sitting No. 050 and its recommendations thereof.

STATEMENTS

1. **STATEMENT: STATUS OF FINANCING LOCALLY LED CLIMATE ACTION PROGRAMME (FLLoCAP)** (Hon. Azhar Din, MCA, Kaloleni Ward, Chairperson, Transport, Roads, Public Works & Infrastructure Development)

Mr. Speaker, Sir, in line with the parliamentary best practices, precedents and conventions, and pursuant to the provisions of the Third Taita Taveta County Assembly Standing Order No. 42(2) (c) relating to the Sitting's ORDER NO. 7 (STATEMENTS), I rise to seek a statement on the status of Financing Locally Led Climate Action Programme (FLLoCAP);

Mr. Speaker, Sir, the Taita Taveta County Assembly approved the Third Supplementary Budget for Financial Year 2023-2024 whereby the Financing Locally Led Climate Action Programme (FLLoCAP) had an allocation of Ksh. 106,053,502;

Mr. Speaker, Sir, it was however noted with concern during the consideration of the Programme Based Budget for Financial Year 2024-2025 that the Department of Water, Sanitation, Environment, Climate Change and Natural Resources had not utilized Ksh.105,079,402 meant for FLLoCAP;

Mr. Speaker, Sir, in view of the above, I would like the Water, Sanitation, Environment, Climate Change and Natural Resources Department through the Chairperson of the Water and Irrigation Committee to furnish this House with the following information;

- i. A detailed report on whether the Department received FLLoCAP funds
- ii. A detailed report on why the Department did not fully utilize the FLLoCAP funds during the Financial Year 2023-2024
- iii. A detailed report on the Department's plans on the utilization of the funds and programmes intended to be implemented.
