1. STATEMENT: STATUS OF MBULIA COMMUNITY LAND MANAGEMENT AND THE PROPOSED STEEL FACTORY IN MANGA – VOI SUB-COUNTY (Hon. Jones Solomon, MCA, Ngolia Ward, Majority Chief Whip)

MR. SPEAKER SIR, in line with the parliamentary best practices, precedents and conventions, and pursuant to the provisions of the Third Taita Taveta County Assembly Standing Order No. 42(2) (c) relating to the Sitting's ORDER NO. 7 (STATEMENTS), I rise to seek a Statement from the Sectoral Committee on Lands and Human Wildlife Conflict Resolution

MR. SPEAKER, SIR, the affairs of Mbulia community land remain shrouded in lack of openness and accountability on matters relating to its management and the proposed steel factory which is to be set up in Manga within the said community land. While we welcome the investment, it would be of great importance that this Assembly gets to understand the arrangements in place for the benefit of our people on account of opportunities that come with the investment.

MR. SPEAKER, SIR, in view of the above, I would like the Lands and Human – Wildlife Conflict Resolution Committee to furnish this House with the following information;

1. The management status of the Community Land on whether the same is due for fresh elections.
2. The tenure of the Community Land Management Committee.
3. The date of the last elections of the Management Committee.
4. The nature of the user rights of the investor on the community land and whether the same is on lease or sale terms.
5. If on lease, the conditions of the lease which is registered or to be registered.

Mr. Speaker, Sir, in line with the parliamentary best practices, precedents and conventions, and pursuant to the provisions of the Third Taita Taveta County Assembly Standing Order No. 42(2) (c) relating to the Sitting's ORDER NO. 7 (STATEMENTS), I rise to seek a statement on the status of County Education Scholarships;

Mr. Speaker, Sir, the Taita Taveta County Assembly approved the Third Supplementary Budget for Financial Year 2023-2024 whereby the County Scholarships and other educational benefits had an allocation of Ksh. 33,000,000;

Mr. Speaker, Sir, it was however noted with concern during the consideration of the Programme Based Budget for Financial Year 2024-2025 that the Department of Education, Libraries, VTCs and ICT did not submit a report on how the Ksh. 33,000,000 meant for scholarships and other educational benefits was utilized during the Financial Year 2023-2024;

Mr. Speaker, Sir, in view of the above, I would like the Education, Libraries, VTCs and ICT Department through the Chairperson of the Early Childhood Development Education (ECDE), Libraries & Vocational Training Committee to furnish this House with the following information;

- i. A detailed report on beneficiaries of the scholarships during the Financial Year 2023-2024.
- ii. A detailed report on the Department's plans on the utilization of the scholarship funds meant for the Financial Year 2024-2025 considering that there will be no form ones in the year 2025 and the allocation still stands with similar amounts as the one for the last financial year which had four classes for consideration.
