THAT, AWARE, Article 1(2) of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010 vests all sovereign power to the people of Kenya, power which may be exercised directly or indirectly through elected representatives.

FURTHER AWARE, Article 10(2) (a) (b) and (c) provides for the national values and principles of governance which include; democracy and participation of the people, inclusiveness, good governance, integrity, transparency and accountability.

ACKNOWLEDGING that Article 196(1) of the Constitution of Kenya provides that a County Assembly shall;

- a) Conduct its business in an open manner and hold its Sittings and those of its committees in public.
- b) Facilitate public participation and involvement in legislative and other business of the Assembly and its committee.
- c) A County Assembly may not exclude the public or any other media, from any Sitting unless in exceptional circumstances the Speaker has determined that there are justifiable reasons for doing so.

FURTHER ACKNOWLEDGING, that Section 91 of the County Governments Act, (No. 17 of 2012 (revised edition 2020), provides that County Government shall facilitate the establishment of modalities, and platforms for citizen participation for example town hall meetings, IT based technologies and establishment of citizen fora at County and decentralized units.

NOTING THAT, the recommendation of the County Assembly Business Committee that a sitting of the County Assembly be held away from the traditional premises in, Wundanyi, during the term of the Third Assembly except during an election year with the objective to provide an opportunity where Members of the County Assembly interact with the Members of the Public to deliberate on issues affecting the County and create a better understanding of the functions of the County Assembly.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to Article 126 (1) of the Constitution, this County Assembly resolves to hold its Plenary and Committee Sittings at any time and place that the House may appoint.
