**Mr. Speaker, Sir,** in line with the parliamentary best practices, precedents and conventions, and pursuant to the provisions of the Taita Taveta County Assembly Standing Order No. 42(2) (c) relating to the Sitting's ORDER NO. 7 (STATEMENTS), a Member of the House can seek a statement requiring availability of information, clarification or appearance on any substantive issue, circumstances, situations and matters appertaining to the attention of County Governments, the National Government, or any Public Entity where such mandates related to the management of service and leadership to the citizens and institutions, as per the Constitution of Kenya, 2010, and our current laws are concerned;

In view of the foregoing, I rise to seek a statement regarding the status of youth welfare in the County concerning employment and access to tendering opportunities.

**Mr. Speaker, Sir,** Article 55 of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010, stipulates that the State shall take measures, including affirmative action programmes to ensure that the youth have opportunities including access to employment and Article 227 on fair, equitable, transparent and cost-effective public procurement of goods and services.

**Mr. Speaker, Sir,** I would like the Chairperson of Youth and Sports Committee to furnish this House with the following information;

- i. How many youth have been employed by the County Government in various departments and entities?
- ii. How many youth have been awarded tender opportunities in the County Government?
- iii. What measures has the Department taken to unlock Youth potential for sustainable wealth creation and development?
- iv. What measures has the Department taken to promote Youth Entrepreneurship through empowerment programmes?
