IKIFAHAMIKA KWAMBA, katika harakati zao za usafiri, madereva wa boda boda hukutana na hata kukumbwa na ajali za barabarani na ajali zinginezo;

IKIFAHAMIKA PIA KWAMBA, madereva wa boda boda wanakumbana na wateja wenye hali tofauti tofauti za afya ambazo zinaweza kudhibitiwa kupitia kwa huduma ya kwanza na hivyo kuokoa maisha;

IKIHOFIWA KUWA, asilimia kubwa ya madereva wa boda boda hawana elimu kwenye suala la huduma ya kwanza na usalama barabarani ya kuwawezesha kutoa huduma ya kwanza wanapopata ajali, wanapokuta mtu au watu wamepata ajali au wanapokumbana na mtu au mteja aliye na tatizo la kiafya kabla ya kuwafikisha waathiriwa hospitalini;

IKIZINGATIWA PIA KUWA, kuna taasisi zenye uzoefu na uwezo wa kutoa mafunzo ya huduma ya kwanza kama vile St. John Ambulance, ambayo imekuwa mstari wa mbele katika kutoa mafunzo na huduma za dharura nchini kwa miongo kadhaa;

TUKIZINGATIA na kuunga mkono lengo la maendeleo endelevu ya Umoja wa Kimataifa (Sustainable Development Goals – SDG) la 3.6 la kupunguza kwa nusu idadi ya vifo na majeraha yatokanayo na ajali za barabarani ifikapo 2030, huku ikifahamika kuwa boda boda hufikia sehemu za ajali kwa haraka na urahisi kuliko magari ya wagonjwa au ambulensi na hata kuliko wahudumu wa afya;

5. The expected timelines within which the County Government of Taita Taveta anticipates the completion of the registration of community land in Taita Taveta County.
